



3. *ideas that*

- mass of oxygen in blood unaffected/stays at 2.0g per litre at low altitudes
  - mass of oxygen in blood falls at higher altitudes
  - starts to fall above 2500 metres
- 1.75 g per litre (at 5000 metres)

Don't credit simply "gets lower as you get high", but don't penalise
