To revise this course, students can be helped by ensuring they know the content in the list below and have a detailed knowledge of their **12 main case studies**. Start of colour coding each part to show how confident you are:

A = Amber partly confident,

G= Green, I know this well

Students should create mind maps, flash cards and parents can help by testing the student using the revision guide which has been offered to all students and was outlined in the newsletter at parents evening.

Students should also do regular exam practice questions. (Students who are 2 or more grades below on their last MOCK exam are required to attend revision sessions one a week at either Monday and Wednesday lunchtimes.

Finally, I have given students a case study booklet with the main features of their case studies. Further reading around and research of these case studies can also form part of their revision.
