

KEEP CHILDREN SAFE

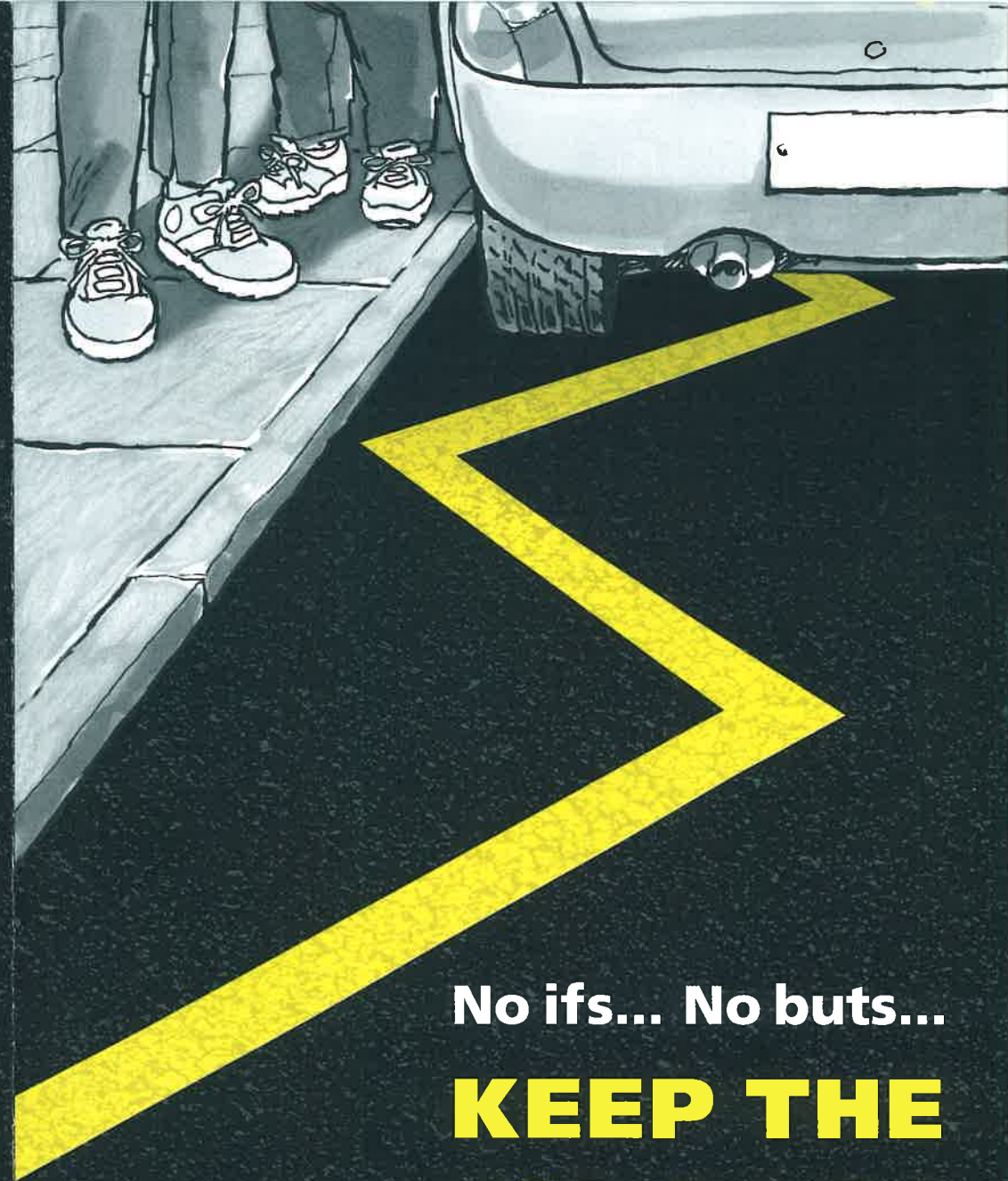
- Don't let very young children out on their own.

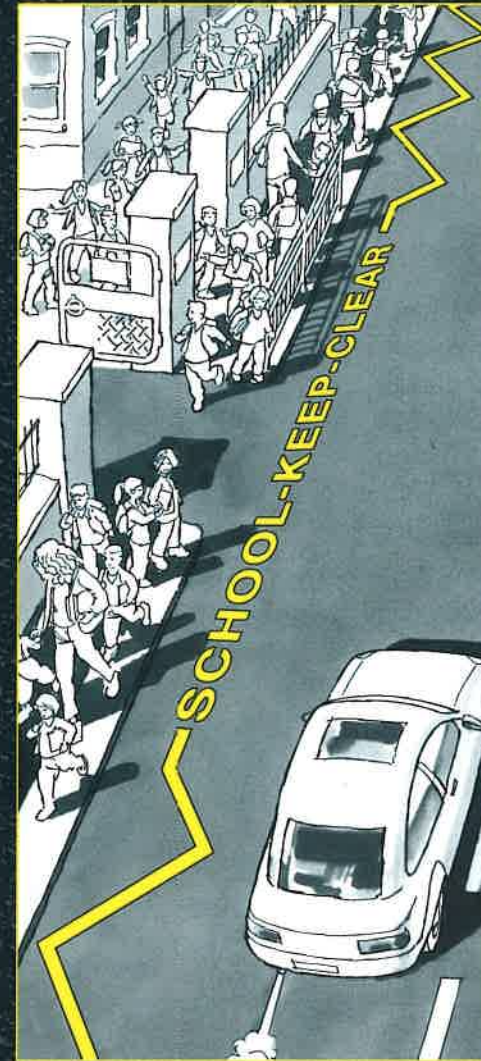
PARKING ON THE ZIG-ZAGS IS DANGEROUS AND SELFISH

Parked cars are a major factor in accidents outside schools.

Stopping on the yellow zig zag lines puts children at risk.

Do **YOU** stop on the zig-zags? What's your excuse?

- You only park there for a few minutes...
- Only when it's raining...
- You were in a hurry...
- Accidents don't happen at your school...



The zig-zags are there for a purpose:

*To provide a clear area in which children can cross **MORE** safely.*

- Because of their size, children cannot see if the road is clear from behind parked cars.
- Drivers cannot see small children hidden by parked cars.
- When children go to and from school, there is usually a lot of traffic.

Put all these problems together and you have the perfect setting for an accident to happen.
