



BEHAVIOUR STEPS

We will begin every lesson with a 'fresh start'. Any negative behaviour from a previous lesson will have been addressed.

We want every student to do their best in every lesson and all students should have the opportunity to learn.

If a student refuses to work, then we will not allow this to interfere with the flow of the lesson, but will contact parents and discuss, prior to the next lesson.

Where a student exhibits negative behaviour, which impacts on the learning of other students, eg talking over the teacher, making silly noises etc, then issue a C1.

If this behaviour persists, follow the steps: C1-C4.

Where behaviour is dangerous, then 'on call' or SLT should be contacted immediately.

- C1**
- Name on board

Behaviour persists

- C2**
- Name on board ticked
 - Move seats if appropriate

Behaviour persists

- C3**
- Behaviour point issued
 - Request colleague to support if possible
 - Log on Class Charts
 - Contact parents

Behaviour persists

- C4**
- Use 'on call' to remove from lesson
 - Pupil to remain in I.R. for the remainder of the lesson.
 - HoY/SLT will meet with the student and decide if they need to go home

Behaviour unacceptable

- C5**
- Parents contacted (HoY)
 - Student sent home with Home School-Agreement

- ZERO TOLERANCE**
- Swearing at a member of staff
 - Aggressive and dangerous behaviour
 - Deliberately breaking H+S rules

- C6**
- Failure to adhere to HS agreement will result in FTE.
