Careers Education Information and Guidance (CEIAG) plays an increasingly important role in education and there have been several informative publications, which provide a framework for the provision of careers education and guidance.

There are two publications that form the basis of our careers plan.

1. The Gatsby Foundation Good Career Guidance (2014) details eight benchmarks, which schools need to meet by 2020.

2. The Careers guidance and access for education and training providers (2018) from the Department for Education also gives clear information about schools' roles and statutory duties regarding their careers provision.

We are committed to providing an extensive programme of careers education for all of our students which aims to provide access to high quality, impartial and unbiased careers information for careers education from Year 7 onwards and encourage them to reach their full potential.

We aim to provide students with information on the range of post 16 qualifications and pathways available to them so that they are making well-informed and aspirational choices.
