	struggle to access subjects across the curriculum
3	Some disadvantaged students have poor attendance compared to their peers.
4	Some disadvantaged pupils face <b>barriers</b> in relation to uniform, equipment and wider educational experiences which prevents them from accessing the curriculum: a wealth of enrichment is needed to widen their horizons, unlock potential and remove potential barriers.
5	A small proportion of disadvantaged students find it difficult adjusting to the <b>expectations</b> in a large school environment and can struggle to manage their behaviour.
